Accumulate all your important information in one place!

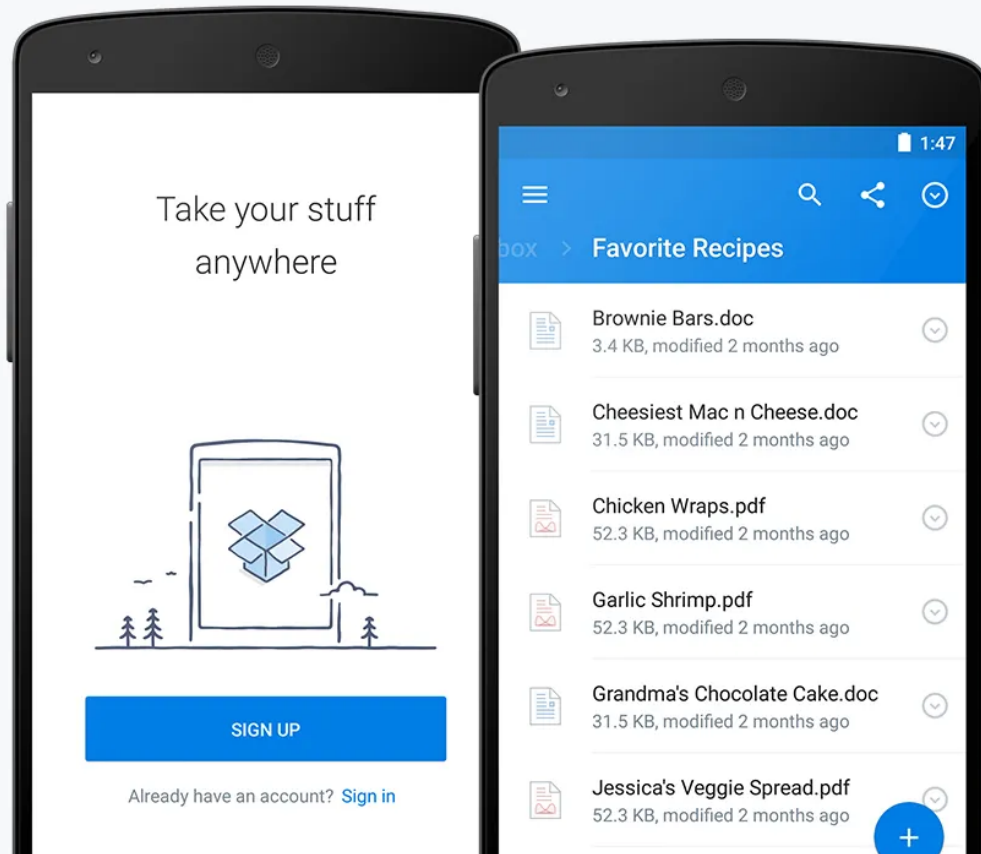
2. Todoist

Aside from making your business routine super-productive, this app is extremely stylish.

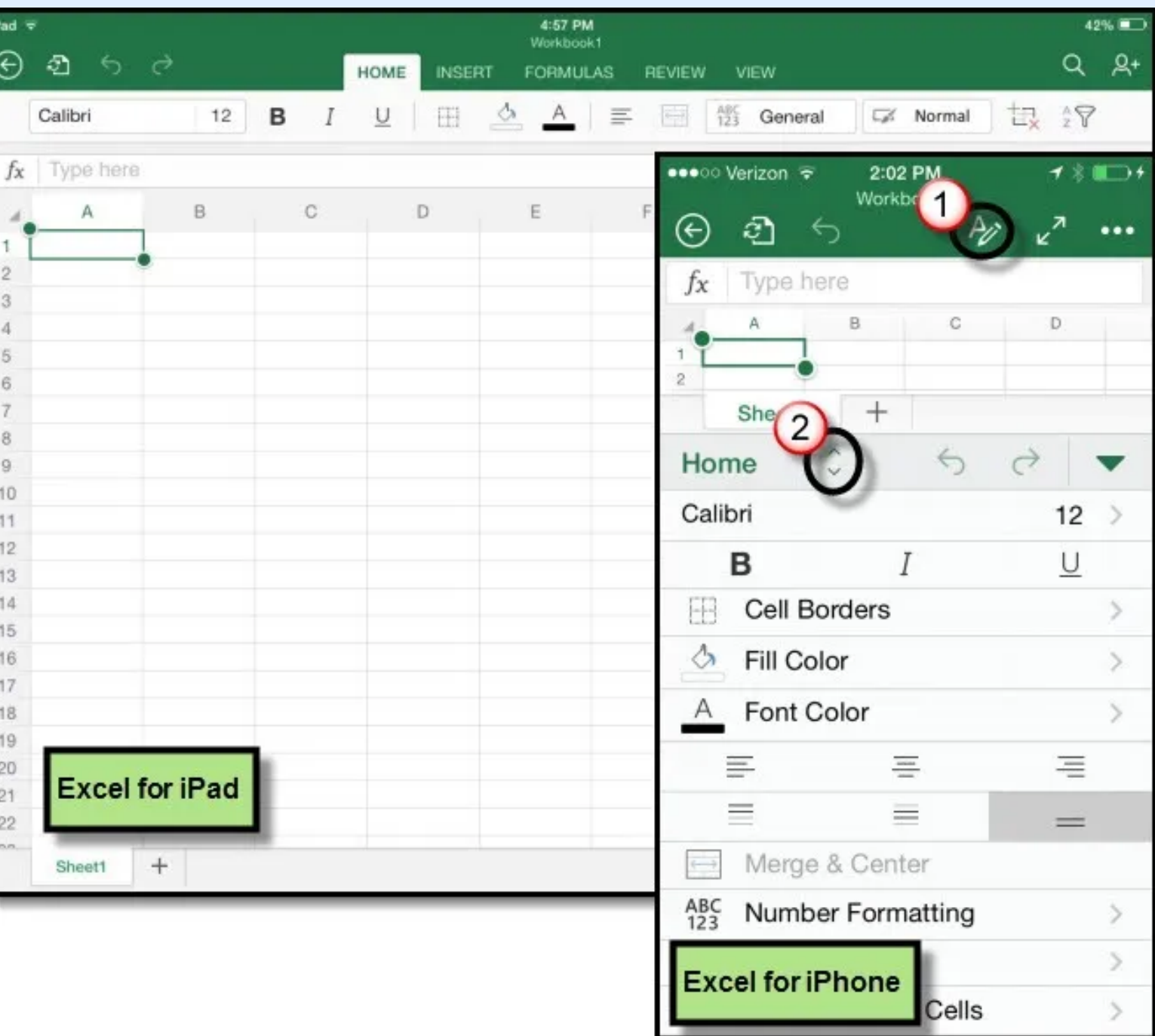
3. Dropbox

- It also allows you to work with documents or send them to your partners and colleagues. [Dropbox](#) on your iPhone automatically synchronises with your laptop or iPad.

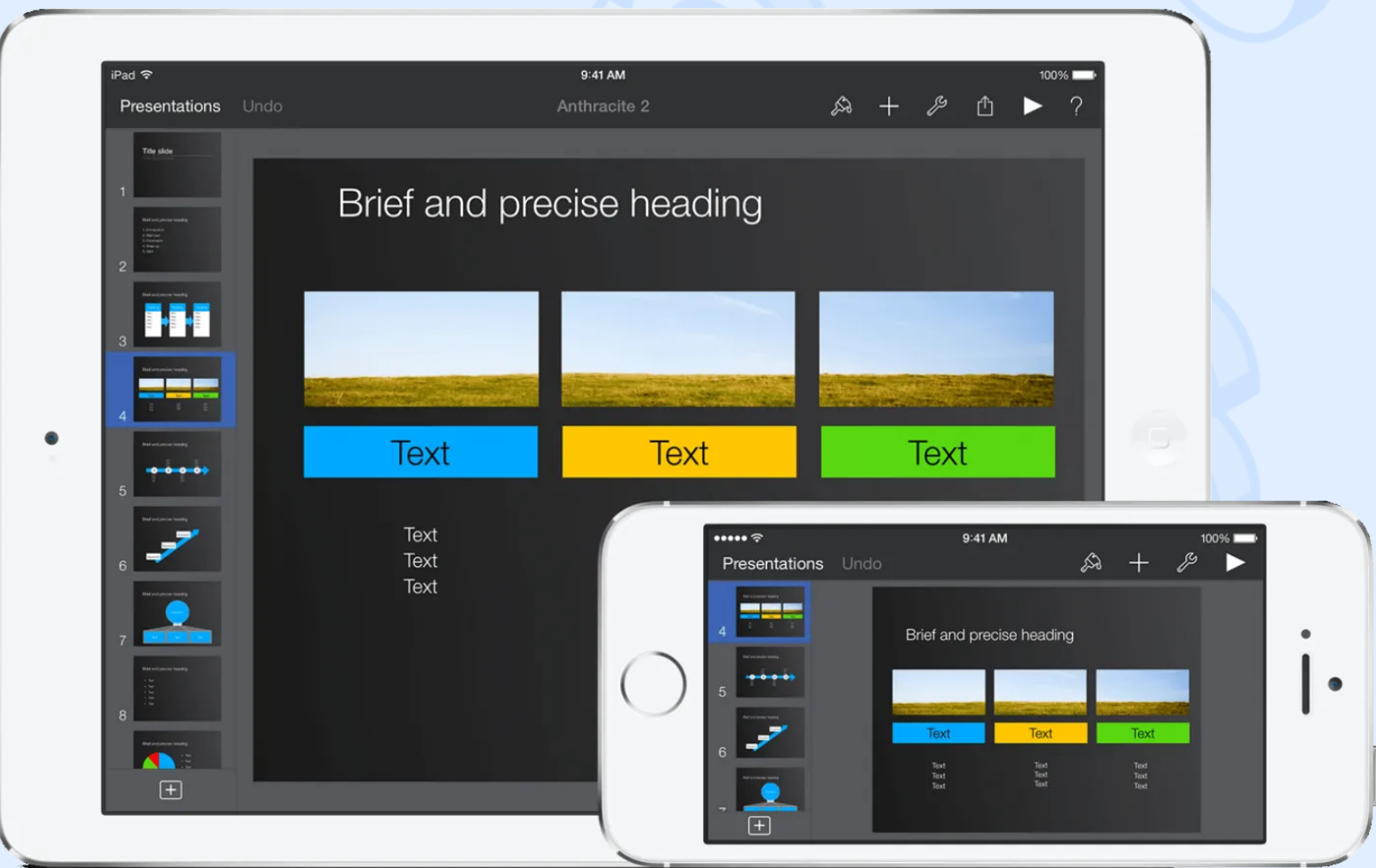
4. Microsoft Excel

- The synchronisation will allow you to continue working with a document from the place where you left off last time – and it doesn't matter which device you open it on.

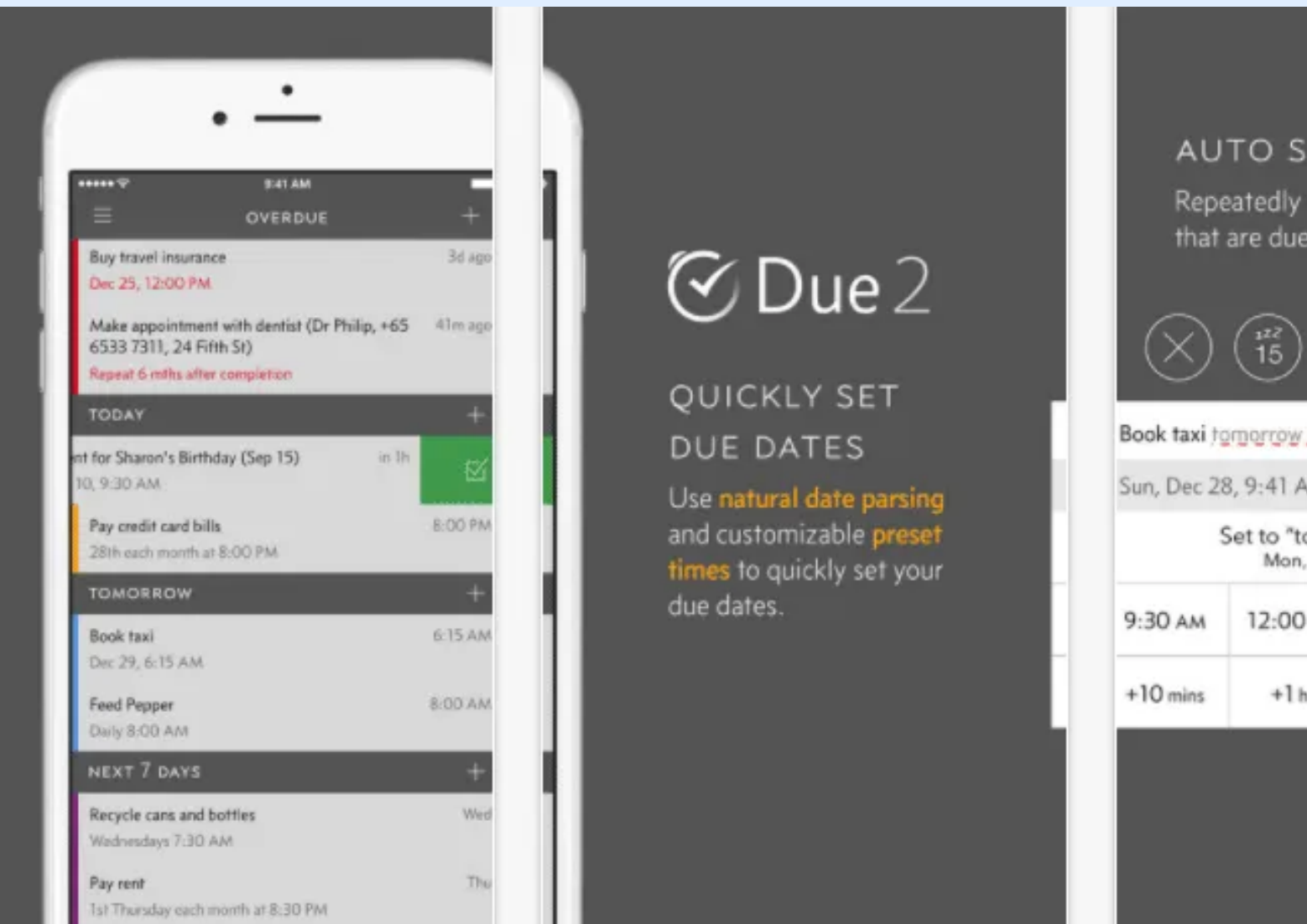
5. Keynote

6. Due

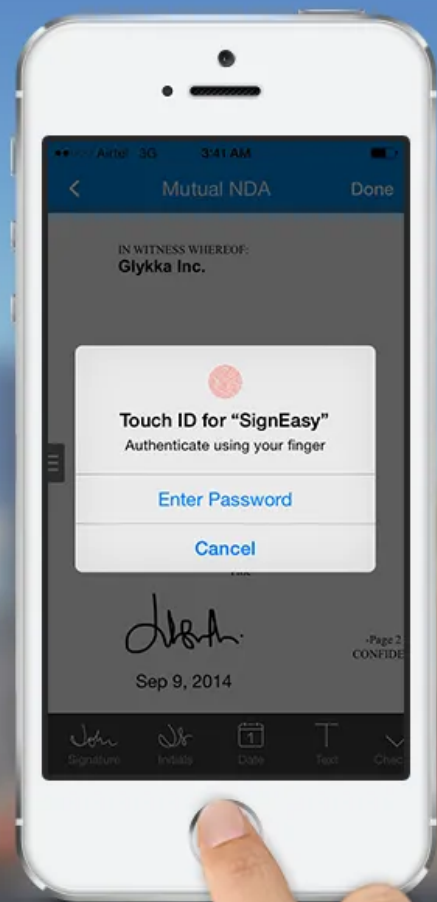
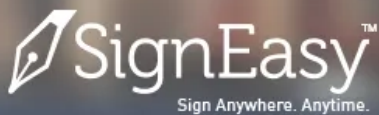


With this application, you'll never forget about an important meeting. It will make sure your day goes as planned and will notify you in advance.

Keeping finances in order is something beyond the control of even experienced bankers and financiers. However, with the [Splash Money](#) app, you'll have a personal assistant in your pocket.

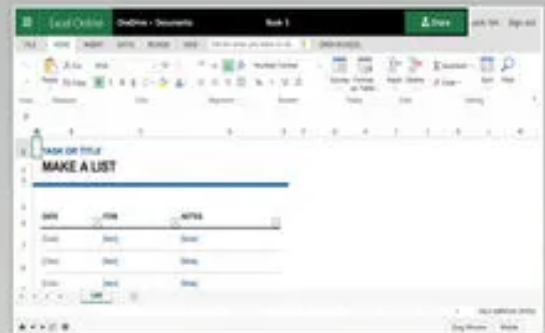
- With this application, planning your budget and analysing your expenses is simple and convenient. You can also include your lending and debt records.

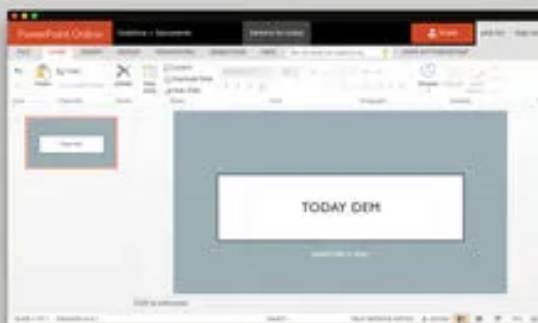

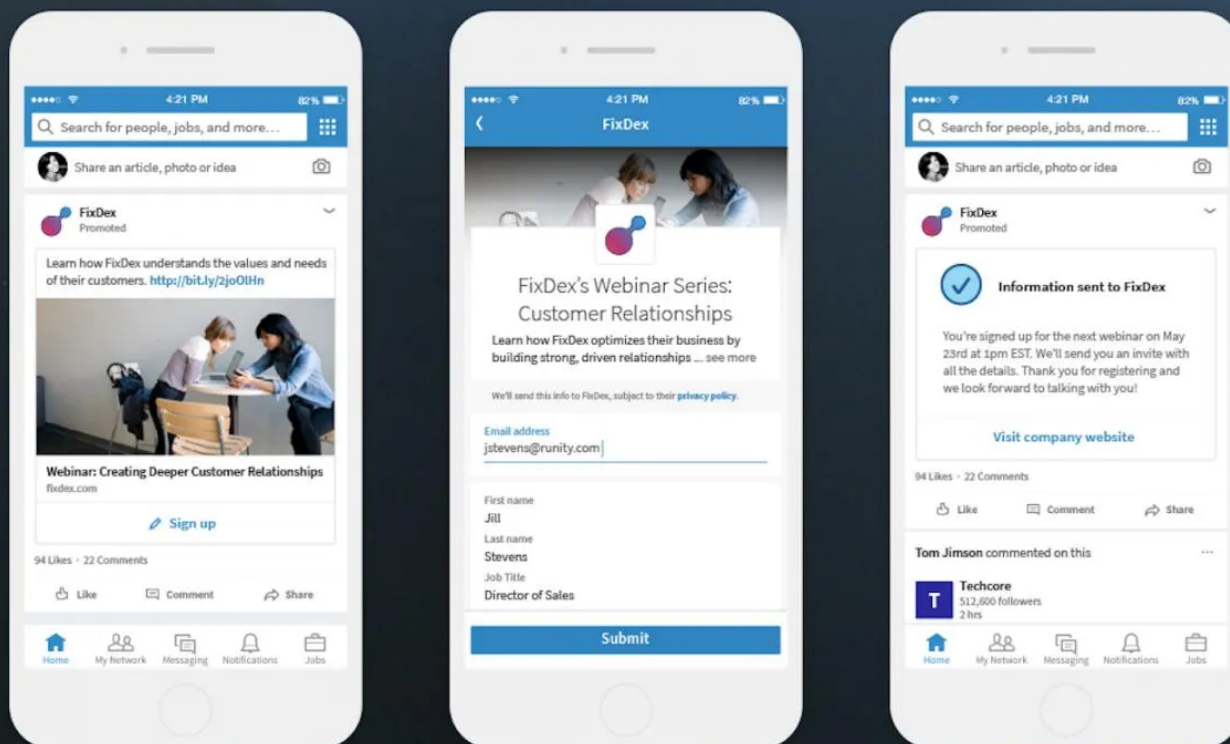

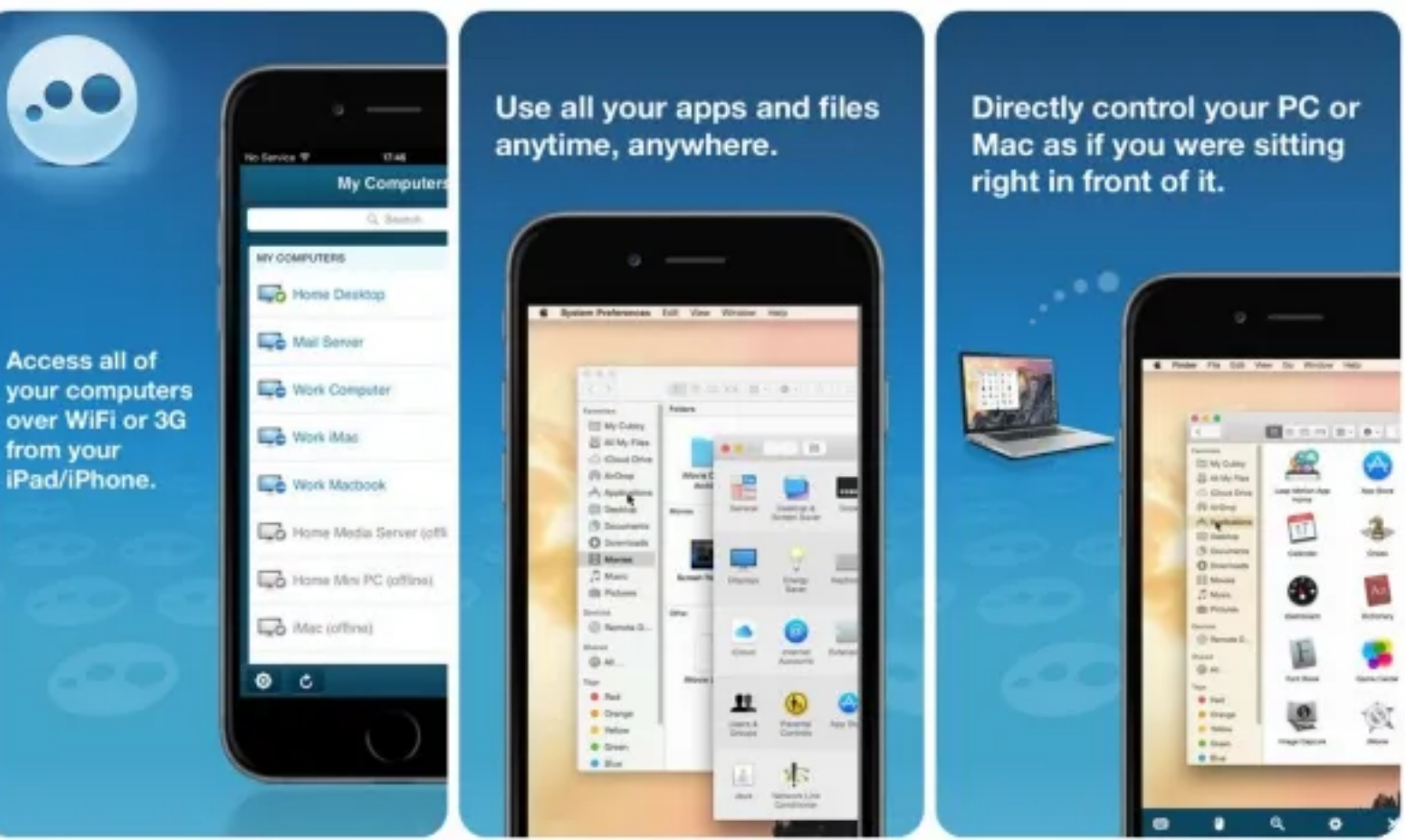
11. LinkedIn

13. 30/30




[30/30](#) helps you to always be punctual in completing tasks.

14. Slack



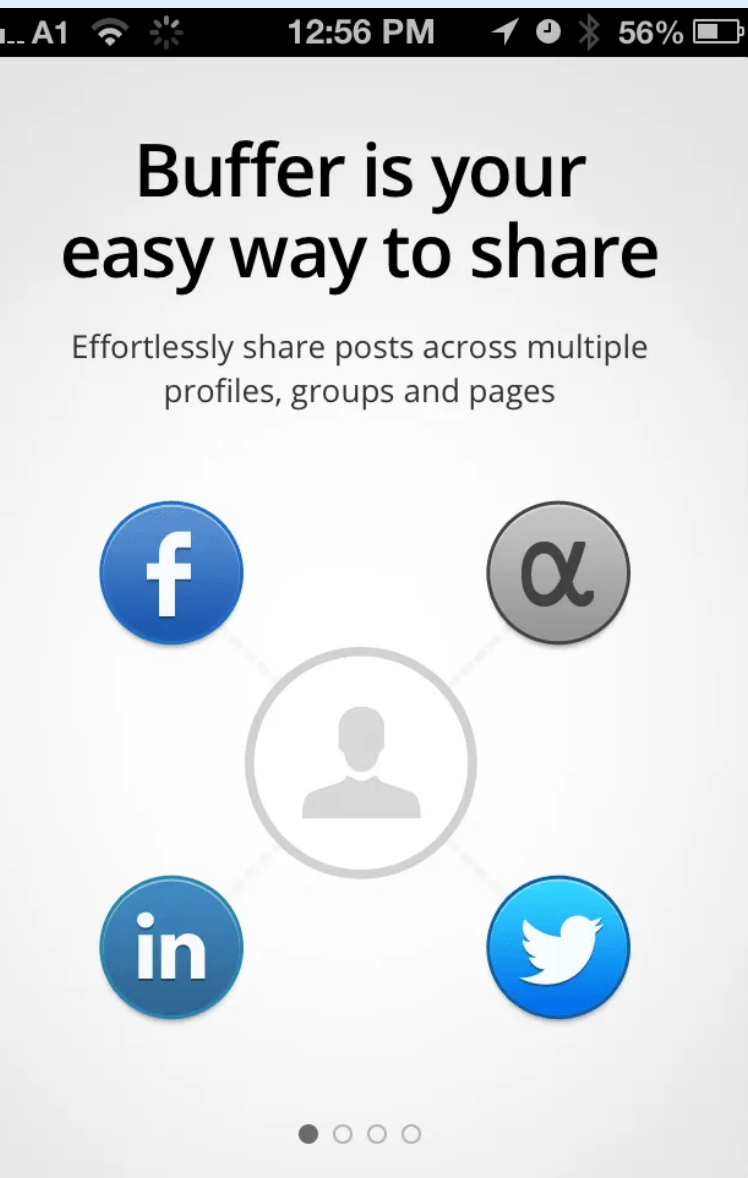
Deep search allows you to find anything fast and easy.
